## **The League will be played on Sundays starting in September 2012 at 11am**

Dart Champions Club was formed in July 2011 to promote darts, at the highest possible calibre. The club's goal is to provide awareness and up-to-date information concerning all aspects of the game of darts, tournaments and all pertinent information concerning the darting community promoting the game of darts. The objective of the league is to promote competitive darts in an organized manner and improve the image of darts at all times.

The Dart Champions Club is proud of its non-discriminatory policy in regards to race, sex and the physically challenged!

Before the season opener in September, around March thru to July, (currently) the club will run "tryouts" at various locations across Southern Ontario. At these "tryouts" the number of members by the form of members' addresses, will then determine the geographical layout and district representation of the league. A district team is made of 7 players.

If a minimum of 30 entries from a particular area (i.e. postal code) is represented at these tryouts, then that area qualifies to be represented/ form a "District Team". If more than 50 entries from the same district, multiple teams can represent the same District!

To qualify for the team; each member has to attend at least 3 of the "open tryouts" at any locations. To make the team, the TOP 7 best overall PPD (Point Per Dart Average) recorded during the round robin preliminaries" open tryouts". If a member plays in more than 3 "open tryouts", only the best 3 PPD averages determine the qualification for the District Team.

With each district team being made up of 7 players, the format of play for the league will be 3 matches of Doubles 601 Best of 3 legs (each player playing a maximum of 2 matches), 14 matches of Singles (a race to 6 legs with the PPD being recorded) players alternating starting order. Teams will travel to different districts, representing their Home District within their divisions and the Players will be matched up against opponents of the same ranking order on the opposing team!

League matches may be rescheduled depending on the weather and this league will run from about September to May. Spectators and fans are most welcome at these matches, and the schedules and scorecards of the matches will be published to promote players, team and more importantly the game of darts!

In May, we will hold a Grand Finale where monetary rewards and recognition awards will be handed out. There will be two parts to the Grand Finale. "The Battle of the Districts", where all districts in one venue will battle against another district for top honours. The second part of the Finale will be a knock out bracket consisting of the top individual with the best 8 PPD and 8 buy-in spots, battling out for the Best of the Best!

### **Approx. Payout Based on 8 Districts Teams only**

- **Inter- District Matches - \$ 600 for first and \$400 for second.**
- **MVP - \$500 (most points earned)**
- **"Battle of the Districts" - \$1000**
- **"BEST of the BEST" - \$5000 (1st-\$2000, 2nd - \$1000, 3rd & 4th -\$500, 5th thru 8th -\$250)**
